

President Messner welcomed newly elected members Vickie and Ben to the council.

Secretary's Minutes of January meeting were M/S/C to be accepted as printed.

- LEAD Overview (completed by the pastor or a key leader)
- ELCA Trend report (which includes congregational reports & US Census data)
- your own website

to paint a picture of what is happening in your church now and steps you can take to join in the mission God has for you.
